NOTIFICATION

In the public interest for reduction of pendency of cases and for settlement of disputes in the Special Lok Adalat scheduled to be held on 08/10/2023, the State Government, after taking into consideration of the Notification issued by the State of Jharkhand, is pleased to prescribe the following offences for imposition of fine as per the following rates:

Tripura Police Act, 2007

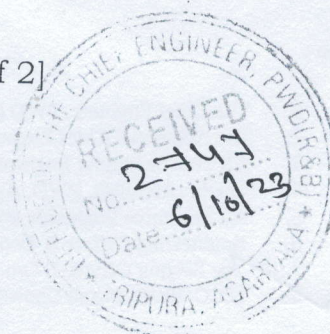
For Section 82,84,85,86,87,88,89 & 90 of the 'Tripura Police Act, 2007', fine to be imposed is **Rs.200/-** (Rupees two hundred only) per offence/case.

Tripura Gambling Act

- (i) For Section 12 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed is **Rs.50** (Rupees fifty only).
- (ii) For Section 13 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed is **Rs.200/-** (Rupees two hundred only).
- (iii) For Section 14 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed is **Rs.300/-** (Rupees three hundred only).
- (iv) For Section 16 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed **for repeat of offences/habitual offenders** is as under:
- (a) For Section 12 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed is **Rs.100/-** (Rupees one hundred only).
- (b) For Section 13 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed is **Rs.400/-** (Rupees four hundred only).
- (c) For Section 14 of Tripura Gambling Act, fine to be imposed is **Rs.600/-** (Rupees six hundred only).

The aforesaid penal amounts are prescribed only in the interest to curb offences which shall not affect the revenue generation of the State.

This Notification shall be applicable only for the purpose of the settlement of disputes in the Special Lok Adalat scheduled to be held on 08/10/2023 and all other subsequent Lok Adalat/Special Lok Adalat to be held time to time in the State until appropriate amendment is made in this regard by the State Government in the Act/Rules.

The APPs of concerned Courts/ Stations are authorized to compound such other petty offence(s)/case(s) and/ or Criminal compoundable cases under any other Acts as may be taken up for disposal in Special Lok Adalats, on behalf of the State.

This shall come into effect immediately and be published in the official Gazette.
